We are now looking for a Production Team (specifically a Director, Choreographer and Stage Manager) to join Musical Director Alan Pring for our Autumn show, *Thoroughly Modern Millie* at Ferneham Hall (performance dates 7 – 10 November).

We are looking for a Director in this instance that has experience in all aspects of stage direction including shows with a strong focus on dance.

They will be working with and supporting a team of experienced people including MD, choreographer and stage manager. They will be responsible for providing the vision for this show as well as delivering this in the rehearsals that take place on Mondays and Wednesdays in Portchester. They will be also advise on Sets, Lighting and Costumes in liaison with the appropriate people and also must be prepared to work to a set budget in all areas of the production.

Thoroughly Modern Millie is a musical with music by Jeanine Tesori, lyrics by Dick Scanlan, and a book by Richard Morris and Scanlan. It is based on the 1967 film of the same name, which itself was based on the British musical *Chrysanthemum*, which opened in London in 1956. *Thoroughly Modern Millie* tells the story of a small-town girl, Millie Dillmount, who comes to New York City to marry for money instead of love – a thoroughly modern aim in 1922, when women were just entering the workforce. Millie soon begins to take delight in the flapper lifestyle, but problems arise when she checks into a hotel owned by the leader of a white slavery ring in China. The style of the musical is comic pastiche. Like the film on which it is based, it interpolates new tunes with some previously written songs.
